FLAGS/LIGHTS



Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.



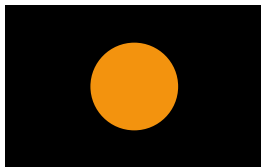
Immediately cease driving at racing speed and proceed slowly, without overtaking and with maximum caution to pits or start line. Obeying marshals instructions and be prepared to stop, should the track be blocked.



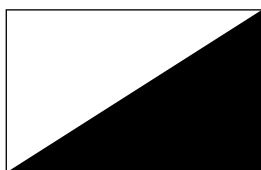
End of danger zone - road clear.



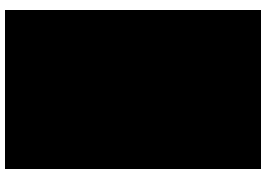
Stationary - Another competitor is following closely behind.

THURSDAY

Test tyres available for purchase from 9am.
Friday Official Practice and wet tyre collection open from 3pm
at the tyre distribution Centre



FRIDAY

Official Practice slick and wet tyre collection open from 8am - 10am
from the Tyre ditribution centre

Up to one set of new practice slick tyres is permitted for all classes.

For all classes in the first instance a maximum 1 set of new slick and wet tyres must be purchased and registered for use in TQ, heats and any finals.

All Race race tyres will be subject to Parc Ferme conditions and can only be used in TQ, Heats and finals.

All New Tyres From Thursday must be purchased through the Championship Organisation.
